



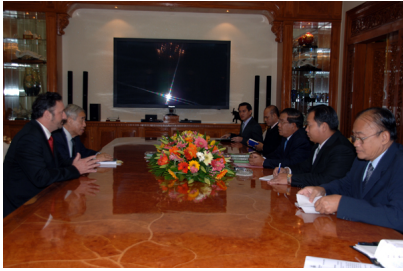
Former UN Secretary-General's Representative in Cambodia Mr. Benny Widyono said that Thailand did encroach on Cambodian territorial integrity as he had clearly studied the history of the Preah Vihear Temple area.

In a meeting here today with Cambodian Prime Minister Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo Hun Sen to handover him his book entitled "Dancing in Shadows: Sihanouk, the Khmer Rouge and the United Nations in Cambodia", Mr. Benny Widyono said he had learned a lot about Preah Vihear Temple and he will help Cambodian ambassador in New York in this matter.
