STATEMENT OF THE SPOKESMAN OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION OF CAMBODIA

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation wishes to clarify on the news report concerning a statement made by the spokesperson of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia on 24 March 2011 as follows:

1. The statement of the spokesperson of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia, as reported by the AFP on 24 March 2011, that Cambodia and Thailand have not yet agreed to accept the deployment of the Indonesian observers is completely contrary to the reality.
2. Cambodia has immediately given its acceptance of the Indonesian observers in the Cambodian site and has already indicated the coverage area for their deployment.
3. On the contrary, it is the Thai side that has repeated acceptance of the observers on Thai soil.
4. I wish to finally report the information mentioned made by the spokesperson of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia.
