The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia presents its compliments to the Royal Thai Embassy in Phnom Penh, and has the honour to draw the latter's attention to further violations of Cambodian territorial integrity by Thailand's armed forces, on 26 April 2011 in the area of TAMONG and TA KHUETH temples, as follows:

At 11AM, one Thai soldier actually violated Cambodian airspace over the area of TAMONG and TA KHUETH temples.

At 11AM, Thai armed forces fired an 152 mm artillery shell into heavily populated Kork Mon area, around 20 km inside Cambodian territory.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Cambodia strongly protest against the repeated violations of Cambodian sovereignty and territorial integrity by Thailand, which not only go against all relevant legal instruments, but also the efforts to seek a peaceful settlement to Cambodia-Thailand border problem.

While remaining committed to finding a peaceful solution to the border problem between the two countries, Cambodia reserves its legitimate rights to self-defence and to responding to sovereignty and territorial integrity.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia asks itself of this opportunity to convey to the Royal Thai Embassy in Phnom Penh the assurances of its highest consideration.
