The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia presents its compliments to the Royal Thai Embassy in Phnom Penh, and has the honor to draw the latter's attention to letter number of Cambodian territorial dispute by Thailand's armed forces, on 26 April 2011 in the area of TAMONG and YA KHABEJ temples, as follows:

At 12.45, on 26 April, several aircrafts violated Cambodian airspace over the area of TAMONG and YA KHABEJ temples.

At 12.45, Thai armed forces fired an 155 mm artillery shell into nearby populated Thai-Mien area, around 25 km inside Cambodian territory.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Cambodia strongly protest against the repeated violation of Cambodia's sovereignty and territorial integrity by Thailand which not only go against all relevant legal instruments, but also the efforts to seek a peaceful settlement to Cambodia-Thailand border problem.

While remaining committed to finding a peaceful solution to the border problem between the two countries, Cambodia reserves its legitimate rights to self-defence and to responding to recovery and enforcement demands.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia asks itself of this opportunity to refer to the Royal Thai Embassy in Phnom Penh the assurance of its highest consideration.
