AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE KINGDOM OF CAMBODIA AND THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND  
ON  
COMPLIANCE WITH THE ORDER OF 16 JULY 2011  
OF THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE

In compliance with Paragraph 10 of Order 22/7/2011 (Case No. 1) (hereinafter the "Order") of the International Court of Justice (hereinafter the "ICJ"), the Royal Government of Cambodia and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") have, in accordance with the Charter of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (hereinafter the "ASEAN"), entered into the following:

1. With a view to implement the immediate withdrawal of all military personnel from the Preah Vihear Temple Area (hereinafter the "PTA") as ordered in Paragraph 10 of the Order, each Party, in cooperation with the Indonesian Observer Team, shall inform the Secretary-General of the ICJ of the military personnel and their positions, as of 15 July 2011, within the PTA.

2. With a view to ensure Cambodia's free access to the Temple of Preah Vihear and to ensure normal administration within the PTA, each Party, in cooperation with Indonesia, shall agree to the ICJ on the basis of any necessary provisions of 15 July 2011 within the PTA.

3. After the entry into force of this Agreement, both Parties request the speedy settlement and dismissal of the Indonesian Observer Team, as listed in Annex A, as ordered in Paragraph 10 of the Order, and as agreed in Paragraph 10 of the Order by the ASEAN Chair on 15 November 2011.

4. Once the Indonesian Observer Team are in place, the Parties shall cooperate with the Indonesian Observer Team to determine the status of Preah A, B, C, and D of the PTA in accordance with the conditions as specified in Paragraph 10 of the Order.

5. Both Parties, in cooperation with the Indonesian Observer, shall draw up a schedule for the immediate withdrawal of all force necessary provisions from the PTA.

6. In accordance with Paragraph 10 of the Order, this Agreement shall not prejudice the status of the ICJ and ICJ shall not be responsible for the border and access security and other in the border.

7. The settlement of claims, compensation and financial claims for the Indonesian Observer Team and responsibilities of Cambodia and Thailand in following the status of the Indonesian Observer Team shall be defined in a separate agreement to be signed between Cambodia, Thailand and Indonesia, in accordance with Paragraph 10 of the Order of the ICJ.

This Agreement will come into effect on the date of signature.
