AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE KINGDOM OF CAMBODIA AND THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND
ON
COMPLIANCE WITH THE ORDER OF 16 JULY 2011
OF THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE

In compliance with Paragraph 13 of Order 22/11/11 (July General List No. 11) hereunder the "Order" of the International Court of Justice hereunder the "Court", the Royal Government of Cambodia and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand hereunder referred to as the "Parties" hereby undertake, in accordance with the Chair of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations hereunder the "ASEAN", to agree on the following:

1. With a view to implement the immediate withdrawal of all military personnel from the Preah Vihear Temple Zone known as the "PZ" as defined in Paragraph 12 of the Order, each Party, in cooperation with the Indochina Observer Team, shall inform the Counter-Party of the date of its military personnel and their positions, as of 15 July 2011, within the PZ.

2. With a view to ensure Cambodia's free access to the Temple of Preah Vihear and to ensure mutual observance within the PZ, each Party, in cooperation with Indonesia, shall agree to the Counter-Party the date of its withdrawal personnel as of 15 July 2011 within the PZ.

3. After the entry into force of this Agreement, both Parties respect the speedy settlement and dispute of the Indochina Observer Team, as defined in ASEAN, as defined in Paragraph 13 of the Order, and as agreed in Paragraph 13 of the Annexes to the ASEAN Chair on 12 February 2011.

4. Once the Indochina Observer Team is in place, the Parties shall cooperate with the Indochina Observer Team to determine the location on the ground of Points A, B, C, and D of the PZ in accordance with the coordinates as specified in Paragraph 12 of the Order.

5. Both Parties, in cooperation with the Indochina Observer, shall draw up a schedule for the immediate withdrawal of all force equipped within the PZ.

6. In accordance with Paragraph 12 of the Order, this Agreement shall not prejudice the work of the UNC and JRC with a view to maintain the border and ensure security and order in the border.

7. The settlement of disputes, negotiation and dispute of the Indochina Observer Team and responsibilities of Cambodia and Thailand in following the terms of the Indochina Observer Team and the related to a dispute agreement to be signed between Cambodia, Thailand and Indonesia, in accordance with Paragraph 13 of the Order of the Court.

This Agreement will come into effect on the date of signature.
