

PRESS RELEASE

On 27 July 2011, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister, H.E. Nanthakij, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Co-operation, with a team led by H.E. Serey Rat, Nanthakij, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Chair of Forum, for working a Joint Agreement between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand, and the Republic of Indonesia on the Subject of the Indochina Chinese Triang, which reads:

"Referring to our two dates (27 July 2011), concerning the proposed Joint Agreement between the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Kingdom of Thailand on Cambodia with the Order of 16/02/2011 of the Government of Cambodia, for the Joint Agreement to be concluded between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Indonesia, shall be held in secret meeting."

"The purpose of this Joint Agreement is to put into effect the objectives of the Indochina Chinese Triang (ICT) to determine on the ground the Potential Transnational Zone (PTNZ) and effectively increase the involvement of both Cambodia and Thailand personnel from the ICT, as well as the Government of the ICT."

"I would highly appreciate it if Your Excellency could give their consideration and early response to this secret agreement."

"I hope to get an early response from this side in the nearest."

"Thank you, Your Excellency, for the assurance of our highest consideration and with warm regards."

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Co-operation also sent a Note to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, with the similar content.
