



PRESS RELEASE

On 27 July 2011, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister, H.E. Nanthouy, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation met with H.E. Serey Chea, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia. During the meeting, a Joint Declaration between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Indonesia on the Subject of the Indonesian-Thai Border was signed.

"Following on our visit dated 27 July 2011 concerning the proposed Joint Agreement between the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Kingdom of Thailand on Cambodia with the Order of 16/02/2011 of the Government of Cambodia, provided for a proposed a mutual Agreement to be concluded between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Indonesia, shall be signed in the near future."

"The purpose of this new Agreement is to put into effect the objectives of the Indonesian-Thai Border (ITB) to determine on the ground the Potential Disputed Zone (PDZ) and effectively resolve the withdrawal of both Cambodia and Thailand personnel from the ITB, as well as the formation of the IBC."

"I would highly appreciate it if Your Excellency could give due consideration and early response to the new Joint Agreement."

"I hope to get an early response from Thailand in this regard."

"Please accept, Your Excellency, the assurance of my highest consideration and with warm regards."

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation also sent a Note to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand with the similar content.
