



PRESS RELEASE

On 27 July 2011, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister, H.E. Nanthakij, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, with a view to His Excellency H.E. M. S. Mani Lal, Ambassador, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Chair of Forum, the working a Joint declaration between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand, and the Republic of Indonesia on the subject of the Indonesian-Thai border, which reads:

"Referring to our joint declaration of 20 July 2011 concerning the proposed Joint Agreement between the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Kingdom of Thailand on Cambodia with the Order of 16/06/2011 of the Government of Indonesia, provided for a proposed a mutual agreement to be concluded between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Indonesia, which should be finalized as soon as possible."

"The purpose of this Agreement is to put into effect the objectives of the Indonesian-Thai border (ITB) to determine on the ground the Potential Disputed Zone (PDZ) and effectively resolve the withdrawal of both Cambodia and Thailand personnel from the ITB, as well as the formation of the IBC."

"I would highly appreciate it if Your Excellency could give due consideration and early response to this mutual agreement."

"I hope to get an early response from this side in this regard."

"Thus, as per, Your Excellency, the assurance of our highest consideration and with utmost respect."

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation also sent a Note to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, with the similar content.
