On 27 July 2011, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister, H.E. Nanthouy, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, with a view to His Excellency H.E. M. B. Hain, M. Nanthouy, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Chair of Forum, the working a Joint Agreement between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand, and the Republic of Indonesia on the Subject of the Indochina Chinese Triang, which reads:

"Referring to our Joint Declaration of July 2010 concerning the proposed Joint Agreement between the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Kingdom of Thailand on Cambodia with the Order of 16/06/2010 of the Government of Cambodia, provided for a proposed a joint Agreement to be concluded between the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Indonesia, which is still in progress."

"The purpose of this Agreement is to put into effect the abolition of the Indochina Chinese Triang (ICT) in order to ensure the peaceful and the stability of the region and to ensure the well-being of the people of Cambodia and Thailand and to ensure the well-being of the people of Indonesia."

"I would highly appreciate it if Your Excellency could give due consideration and early response to this proposal."

"I hope to get an early response from the Thai side in this regard."

"Thank you, Your Excellency, for the assurance of our highest consideration and with warm regards."

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation also sent a Note to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, with the similar content.
