The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia presents in compliance to the Royal Decree in Phnom Penh and, with reference to the Ministry Order N° 06/ MEA/CCIA and N° 04/ MEA/CCIA dated 01 April 2011 and N° 06/ MEA/CCIA dated 01 April 2011, the following to show the latest situation in border villages of Cambodia territory along by Thailand's border fence, which occurred in the morning of 27 April 2011, as follows:

On 27 April 2011, Thai armed forces resumed another shelling on Cambodia border in the area of TAKUM region, at 06:00 and at 22:30 in the area of TA KADREY Tonleap.

On 28 April 2011, Thai armed forces still continued their shelling on Cambodia border, supported by heavy artillery shelling in the area of Cambodia's border of TAKUM and TA KADREY, as well as three border areas of Kampong Speuk District (Uttar Mondul Province).

Subsequently, Thai armed troops, supported by another shelling, attacked Cambodia border adjacent area of O'Ranch region. Fighting still persisted at 06:00 until 28 April 2011.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Cambodia continues to strongly protest against the repeated and continued violation of Cambodia sovereignty and territorial integrity by Thailand, which not only go against all relevant legal agreements, but also the efforts to seek a peaceful settlement of Cambodia-Thailand border problem.

While remaining committed to finding a peaceful solution to the border problem between the two countries, Cambodia reserves its legitimate rights to self-defence and to safeguard its sovereignty and territorial integrity.

Once again, Cambodia appeals to Thailand to respect the United Nations Security Council Resolution no 2045 (1992) and the Statement of the ASEAN Chair on 22 February 2011, and accept the Indonesian mediation in order to avoid further armed conflict.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia seeks out of this opportunity to reiterate to the Royal Thai Embassy in Phnom Penh the assurance of its highest consideration.
